



Union Park Move

The MBTA Union Park stop on the Silver Line has been moved 500 feet down Washington Street in order to make room for the redevelopment of the Penny Savings Bank. The project includes 23 luxury residences, retail space and underground parking. The move will also allow for the recreation of entrance canopies modeled after the bank's 20th century appearance. The Union Park bus stop is now in front of the Blackstone Elementary School.
